Introduction

The Urban Education Alliance (UEA) is a member organization of students, parents, educators, businesses, and concerned citizens devoted primarily to the learning and development of minority students in urban school systems. Each understands the value of the “village concept of raising a child” and supports the holistic needs of each child and the school system in which he or she attends.

The UEA facilitates comprehensive support for students by organizing parents, educators, professionals, and community organizations focused on preK-12 schools. Secondly, it informs and educates educators, parents, and organizational leaders about community-based resources that assist children as they persist through preK-16 educational programs.

Thirdly, it advocates for more rigorous coursework among students such as participation in enrichment or AP courses, college preparation and testing, and college coursework. Fourthly, it advocates for measures that assure alignment of classroom curricula with educational standards and with culturally appropriate value constructs.
